## This week in phonics...

**Expressive Arts & Design:** Perform, compose, feel.

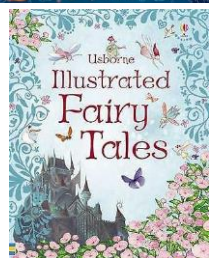
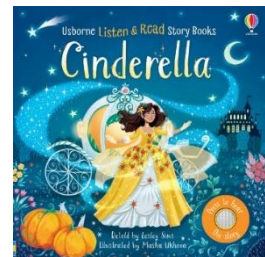
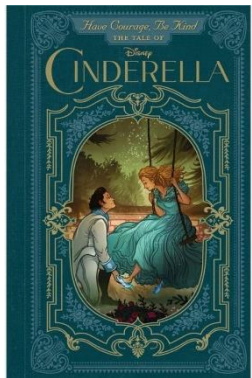
